**SUPPLEMENT TO RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO
GOVERN FURTHER PROCEEDINGS**

On October 31, 2007, respondent Robert M. Gates filed a Motion to Govern Further Proceedings. Respondent explained that, although he initially expected to convene a new CSRT on or before November 13, 2007, the collection and review of additional information for that CSRT has not proceeded as rapidly as expected and respondent did not believe the CSRT would be convened by that date.

Since the filing of that motion, the Department of Defense has updated its estimate concerning petitioner's new CSRT. Respondent now expects that, on or before December 3, 2007, the new CSRT will convene (that is, the detainee will be provided with an unclassified summary of the evidence and a tribunal will be

constituted). If petitioner does not request additional evidence or witnesses, respondent expects that the CSRT hearing will be held on or before December 6, 2007. If petitioner requests additional evidence or witnesses, respondent estimates that the hearing can be held on or before January 5, 2008.


Respondent therefore requests that the Court continue to suspend the current briefing schedule pending completion of the new CSRT.


